

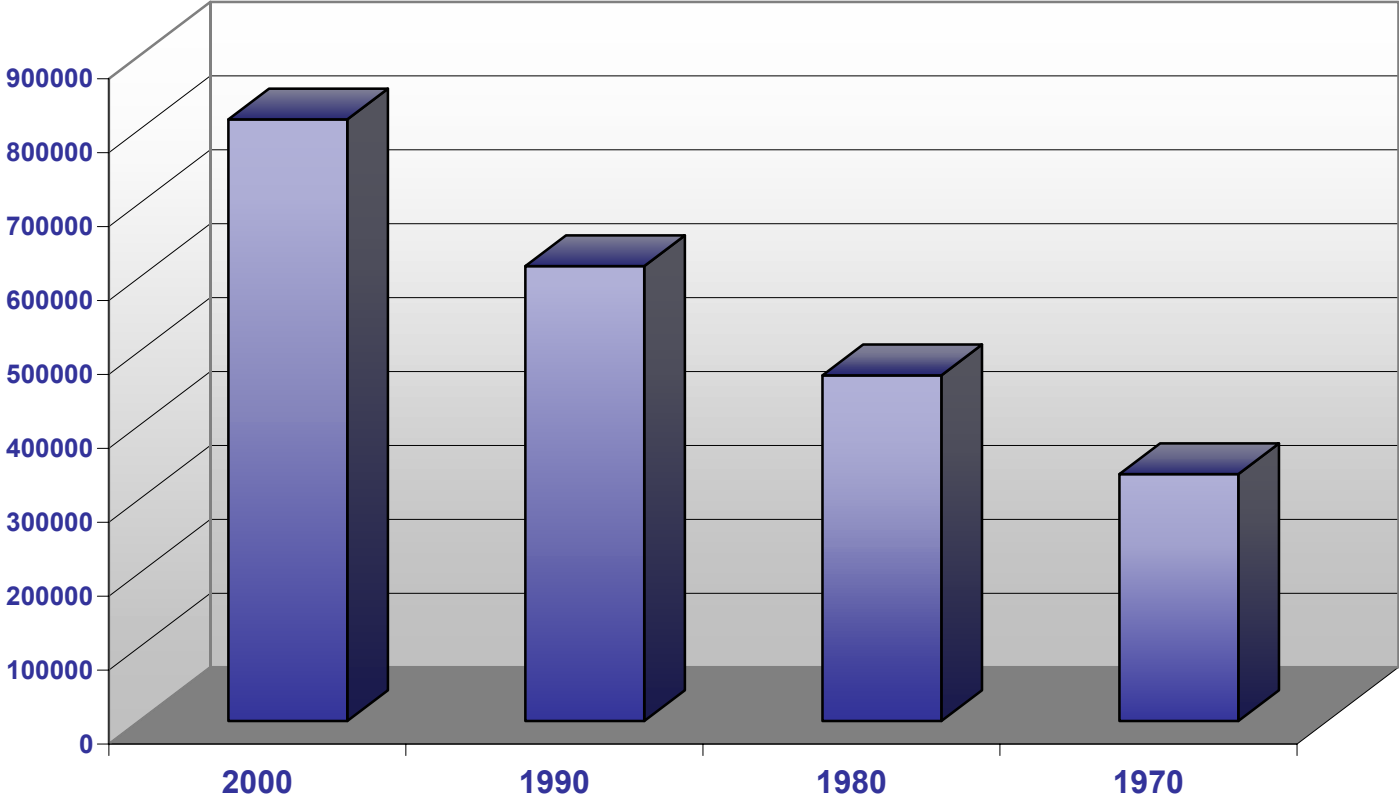

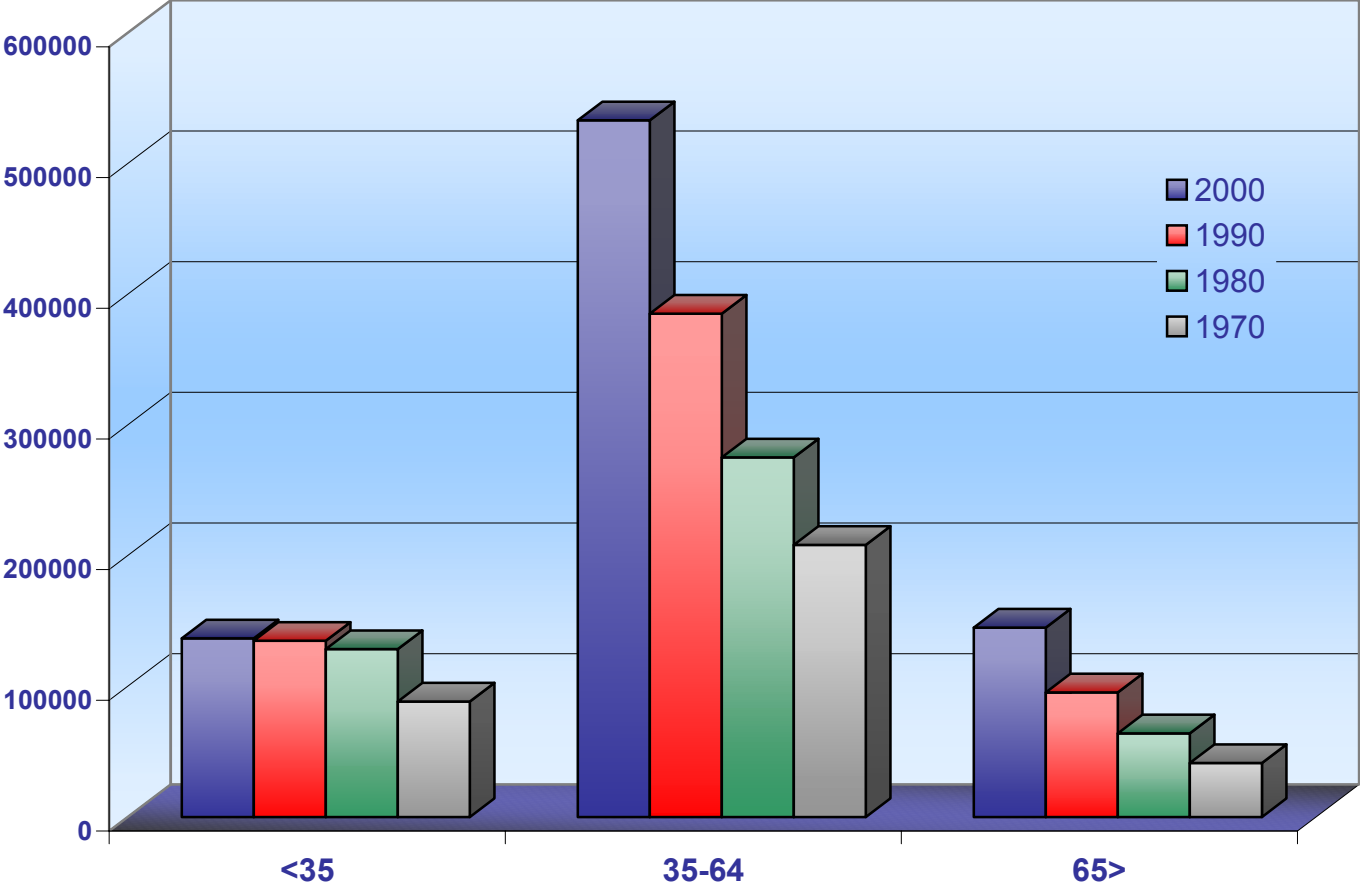

Total Physicians



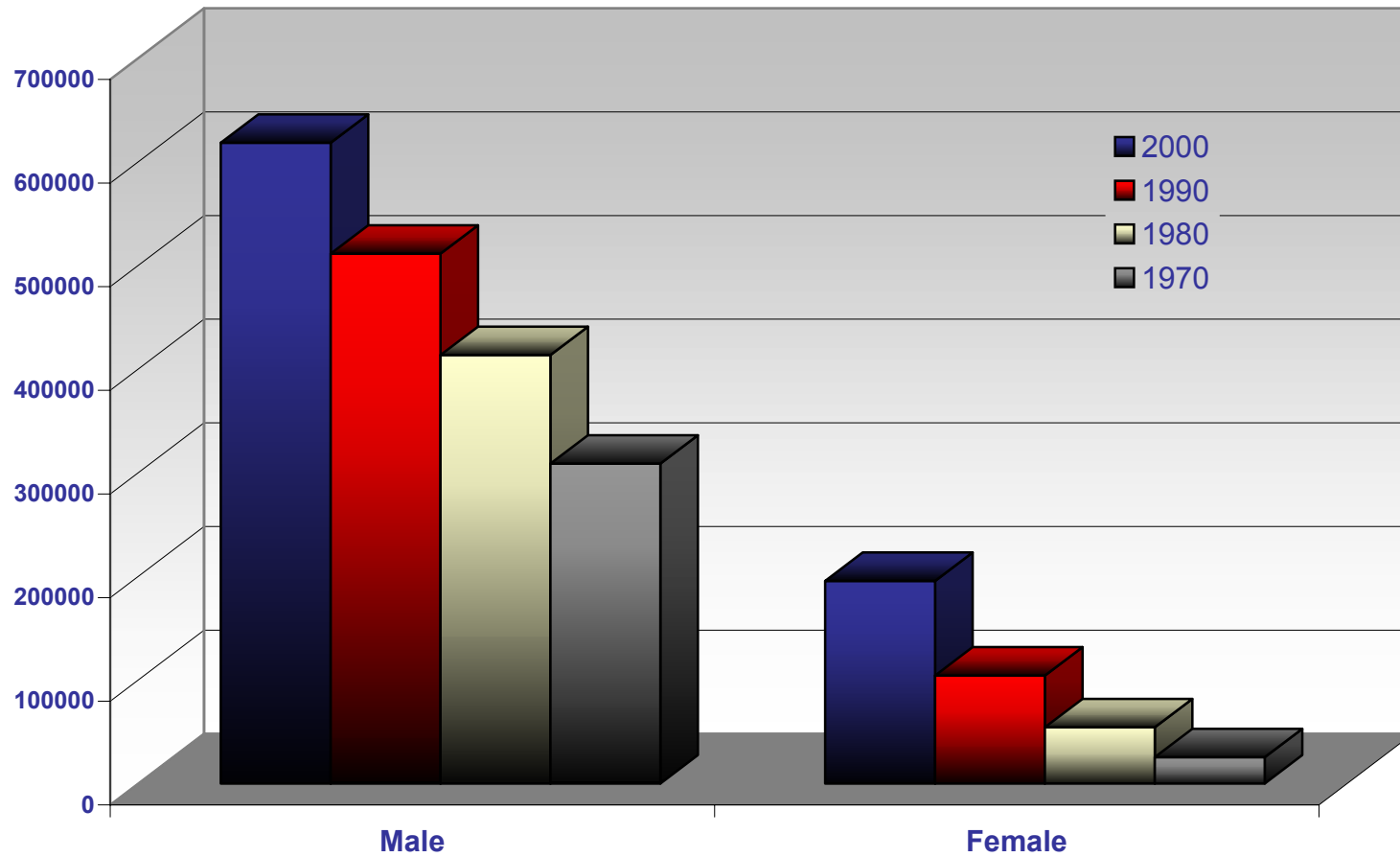

Physicians By Age



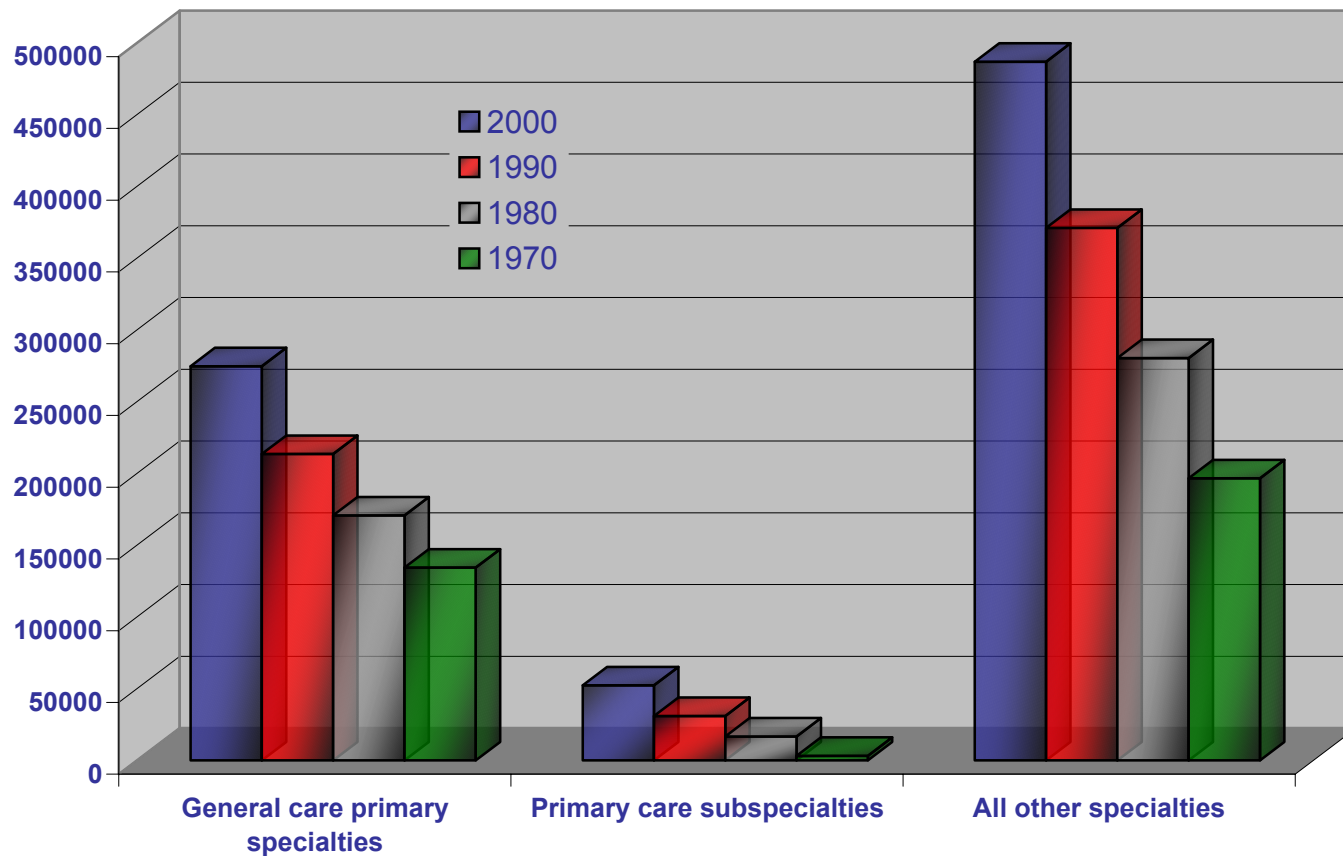

Male/Female Physicians



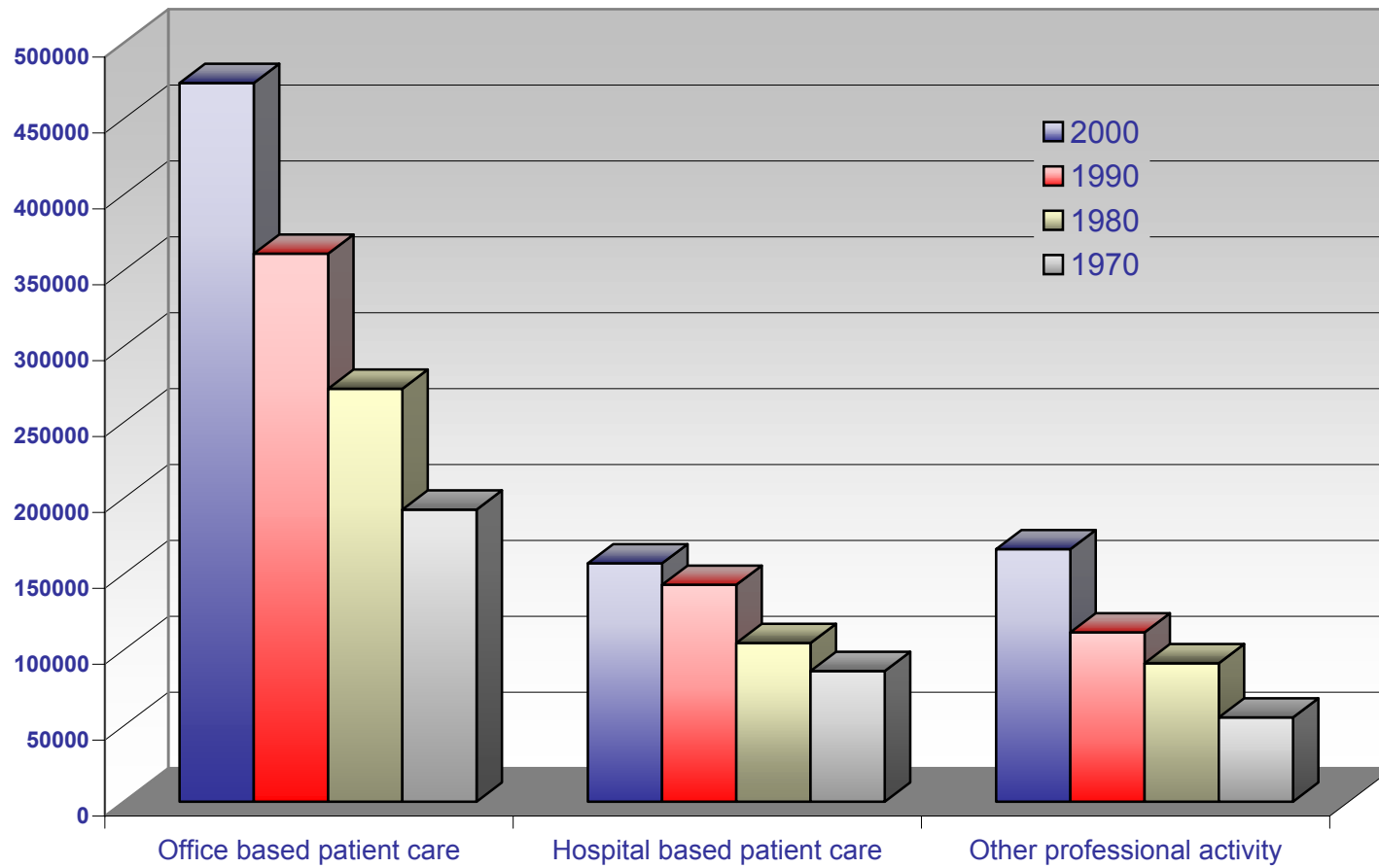
